CONSTITUTION OF THE BIBLICAL NATION OF ISRAEL (TRIBE OF JUDAH)

Preamble:

In the spirit of our forefathers Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and in dedication to the Yah of Israel, we, the descendants of the Tribe of Judah, hereby establish this Constitution to guide our nation in righteousness, justice, and the pursuit of holiness according to the commandments given by Yah to Moses and the teachings of our Rabbi, Yeshua of Nazareth.

Article I: Sovereignty and Dominion

- 1. **The Ten Commandments**: Serve as the fundamental legal and moral foundation of our society. Every law and decree shall align with these commandments.
- 2. **Love**: The greatest commandment is to love The Most High our God and to love our neighbor as ourselves. This principle shall guide all our laws, judgments, and interactions.
- 3. **Equity and Justice**: All citizens, regardless of status or tribe, are entitled to equal treatment and justice before the law. The rights of the stranger, the orphan, and the widow shall be protected.

Article III: Governance

- 1. **Leadership**: Leaders shall be chosen for their wisdom, righteousness, and ability to lead according to Yah's laws. They are to serve the people by upholding justice, promoting peace, and ensuring the welfare of all.
- 2. **Priesthood**: The Levitical priesthood along with Crown of Judah shall oversee religious rites, festivals, and the teaching of the laws. They shall serve as spiritual guides to the nation, maintaining the holiness of the Tabernacle/Temple.
- 3. **Prophets**: The Biblical Nation of Israel shall heed the words of Yah's prophets, who are sent to call the nation back to righteousness, warn of impending judgment, and proclaim Yah's promises.

Article IV: Social Order

- 1. **Community**: The tribe of Judah shall live in community, sharing in feasts, celebrations, and times of mourning, reflecting the unity and diversity of our people.
- 2. **Stewardship**: Every individual is entrusted with the stewardship of Yah's creation. It is our duty to care for the land, the animals, and all resources with respect and wisdom.
- 3. **Education**: The teachings of the Torah, the Prophets and Yeshua Hamashiach shall be taught diligently to our children, ensuring that every generation knows the works and commandments of the Yah.

Article V: Mission

- 1. **The Great Commission**: Following the teachings of Rabbi Yeshua, we are called to make disciples of all nations, teaching them to observe all that we have been commanded, baptizing them in the NAME of the Father (Yahweh), the Son (Yeshua), and the Holy Spirit (Ruach).
- 2. **Service**: We are to be a light to the nations, serving others in love, promoting peace, and bringing the knowledge of the one true Creator to the ends of the earth.

This Constitution, inspired by the sacred Scriptures, shall be the supreme law of The Biblical Nation of Israel (Tribe of Judah).
